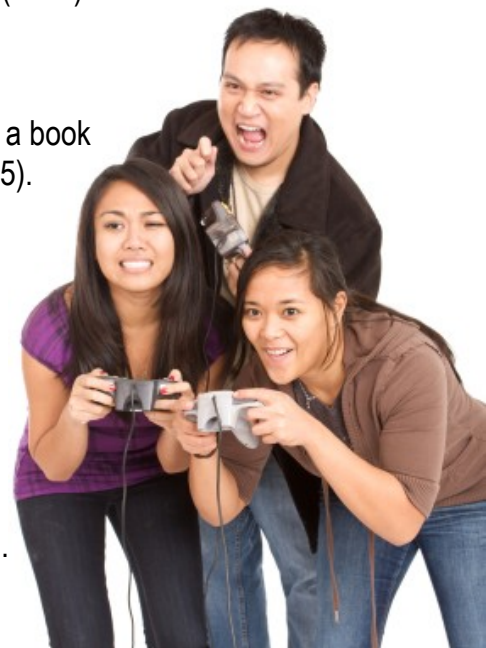

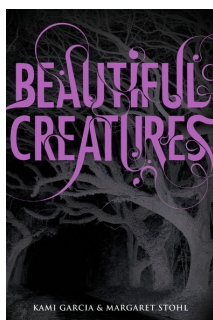

Lost in the black abyss, the only thing he has to hold onto is a girl. Lena Duchannes is the new girl in a small town and definitely hated for her differences. But there is not much you can do when your uncle is the town's Boo Radley, and you have the powers of a young caster who is barely in control. And if all that wasn't enough, there was the dream. Lost in the black abyss and the only thing keeping her safe was a boy. Two fates collide, held together by a haunting past. Time is running out, and the whole town is against them though they have no idea how important their mission really is to their town and their lives. The choice is about to be made, but if it's made for them nothing could stop the power unleashed. The small town of Galin, South Carolina just might find itself turned upside down.
