

Using Freegal with iTunes

1. Go to Freegal on BCPL's webpage or www.freegalmusic.com/users/sndlogin
2. Login with your library card number.
3. Search for music by genre, artist, etc.
 - You can listen to a song prior to downloading it by clicking on the arrow before the song title.
4. Click on Download Now and save the song to your Desktop.
5. Open iTunes.
 - You may need to make the iTunes window smaller by placing the mouse pointer on the far left and clicking and dragging to the right (the mouse pointer needs to be a 2-headed sizing arrow) until you can see the song files on the Desktop.
6. Click on Music.
7. Click and drag the song files into the Music list.
 - You can re-expand the iTunes window.
8. Plug in your iTunes device, such as an iPod.
9. Click on the device's name (and on the Music tab, if necessary)
10. Click on Sync.
 - All the files should load. Click on Artist or Name (to view the song list) to make sure the files are there.
 - If an error message appears saying it couldn't load a song, look at the song list. You will probably see two of the same song listed, with an error flag in front of one of them. Right-click on the song and delete it.
11. Click on the up arrow next to the device to close it.
12. Click on File and Exit to close iTunes.

Note: Freegal has a Recent Downloads link that you can click on to view song files. If a song doesn't get properly transferred to iTunes, you can reload it without counting against your weekly download number of three.
