

### **2012 Flip Out for a Good Book Contest Rules:**

- Participants must be in Middle or High School. Participants may work and submit a video as a team or as an individual, but prizes will be awarded as stated. There will not be multiple prizes awarded to multiple team members. One prize per individual/group.
- Book selected for a trailer or review may be a children's, YA, or adult title.
- Videos should not exceed 3 minutes in length.
- Images and sound may be of original content or chosen from fair use material, such as creative commons and public domain resources; videos must be your own original work - plagiarism and stolen work will not be accepted!
- No obscene language, images, or audio will be accepted.
- Videos may either be emailed to [teen@bcpl.org](mailto:teen@bcpl.org) **OR** uploaded to YouTube:
  - If videos are uploaded to YouTube, they must include the following three tags:
    - BooneLibrary
    - 2012 TTW
    - Flip4GoodBook
- The final day to email/upload videos is Wednesday, February 29, 2012.
- Submissions will be narrowed down to 6 finalists by library staff. During Teen Tech Week - from March 5-10, 2012 - finalists' videos will be featured on the BCPL Teen Scene website and Facebook page for voting.
