Information for Prospective Trustees

Boone County Public Library is a public agency subject to the Kentucky Open Records Act (KRS 61.870-61.884). Applications and related documents may be subject to public records requests.

Procedure for filling a Board vacancy [KRS 173.490]:

- 1. For each vacancy, the Board selects two [2] candidates committed to library service.
- 2. Names are submitted to the Kentucky Department for Libraries and Archives (KDLA);
- 3. The State Library Commissioner approves and forwards recommendations to the County Judge Executive.
- 4. The County Judge Executive nominates one [1] candidate to the Fiscal Court for approval.
- 5. If rejected, the second candidate may be submitted to the Fiscal Court.
- 6. If both are rejected, KDA may submit two [2] qualified individuals from the submitted applications.
- 7. The County Judge Executive resubmits a nominee to the Fiscal Court.
- 8. If the Fiscal Court rejects the nominee, the County Judge Executive nominates a qualified person of his/her choosing. This step repeats until a candidate is approved.
- 9. Approved nominees take the Oath of Office before an appropriate official.

Board terms and compensation [KRS 173.490]:

- 1. Trustees may serve for two [2] consecutive terms [four years each]; after this, they must wait at least one [1] year before serving again.
- 2. Trustees are not compensated but are reimbursed for expenses incurred in performing their duties.

Board meetings and attendance [KRS 173.490]

- 1. The Board meets monthly.
- 2. Absence from four regular monthly meetings within one year [1] constitutes automatic resignation.

Conflict of interest [KRS 173.510]:

1. Individuals directly or indirectly involved in selling goods to the Library are not eligible to serve as trustees.
